

 - offers engravers on a sign-out basis.





Outside Doors



- Ensure that exterior doors are equipped with security chains. Use the chains at night or when you are gone.
- Use the security bolts on the top and bottom of the door at night, and on all doors you are not using if you are gone. If you are going on leave or a trip, set all the bolts and leave through the garage door.
- Double lock the door at night, and any time you leave the house.

Windows

- Close all downstairs windows when you go to bed at night.
- When you leave the house, close all windows.
- Make sure windows are latched securely.
- Make sure security thumb button latches are installed on downstairs windows.




Lights

- Leave outside lights on during hours of darkness - even if you are home.
- Leave a light on downstairs when you go to bed or are out of the house.
- If you are going on a trip, leave some lights on a timer, or have a friend turn them on and off periodically.





Outside

- Make sure fences are undamaged.
- Keep hedges, plants or trees from growing in front of windows and doors.
- Keep security lighting on. Consider motion sensor lighting.



And Still Outside...

- Restrict outside access to upstairs windows.



- Lock all gates unless they are in use.

Vacation



- Register with the MP Station for Operation Travel Watch - have the KMAR check the outside of your quarters.
- When you go away on vacation or a trip, leave a key with a neighbor to check your quarters.
 - Have your key holder remove mail from under the mail slot and place it out of sight.
 - Have your key holder move any cars left in the driveway periodically.
 - Have the lawn mowed while you are gone.
- Use lamp timers to give your house that lived in look.

Other Measures



- When leaving the house for short periods of time, leave the television or radio on to give the appearance that someone is home.
- Always leave the blinds partially or fully closed if you are not at home, or are in bed - don't advertise your possessions.

If Something Happens

- While you are at home:
 - **Do NOT** take action yourself.
 - Dial 112 and ask for the Politie.
 - Give your address, phone number, and nature of the call calmly and clearly. Follow their instructions.
 - Notify the MP's at 046-443-7555.
- While you are away:
 - Call the MP Desk Sergeant at 046-443-7555.
 - Explain the nature of the call. Give your name, address and phone number.
 - Give an estimate of damage and/or loss.
