			<b>NEIGHBORHOOD, ROADS, AND PARKING</b>
			1. Is the dwelling near an industrial zone, power plant, or other hazard?
			2. Are there adequate/multiple entry and exit roads from the neighborhood?
			3. Is the dwelling located on a dead-end street?
			4. Is the dwelling a single family house? If no, what type of building is this? Duplex/Multiplex/Apartment/Row House/Other
			5. How many families live in this dwelling (approximate)?
			6. Of what material is the residence constructed?
			7. Are workmen allowed in the house/grounds when the resident is absent?
			8. Are workmen's appoints scheduled in advance?
			9. Does the dwelling have underground parking?
			10. Does the dwelling have garage parking?
			11. Is off-street parking, adjacent to the dwelling, available?
			12. Is the mailbox attached to the dwelling and the name shielded from public view?
			13. Are there English speaking people in the neighborhood?
			14. Do you feel the residence, and the neighborhood, is safe and secure?
			<b>DOORS:</b>
			1. Does the dwelling have multiple entry/exit doors?
			2. Can all exterior doors be locked (basement, patio, balcony, French, etc.)?
			3. Do all exterior doors have deadbolt type locks?
			4. Are the locks either double cylinder or single cylinder?
			5. Are the cylinder base plates made of solid metal rather than hollow wood?
			6. Have short screws in the cylinder base plate been replaced with 2 ½ inch screws?
			7. Is there nearby glass or thin wood panels near the locks?
			8. Are all exterior doors / door frames made of metal or solid wood?
			9. Are doors without cylinder locks provided with a heavy bolt or other secure device that can be operated only from the inside?
			10. Will lock cylinders be changed and new keys given to the new tenant?
			11. Do exterior doors have a peephole or intercom system?

			<b>WINDOWS:</b>
			1. Are all of your exterior windows fixed with locks that work from the inside only?
			2. Are all windows secure and in good repair?
			3. Are windows able to be locked in a partially open position for ventilation?
			4. Are bars, ornamental grills, or rolladen on all ground floor and basement windows?
			5. Are there architectural features which may allow access to your home such as trellises, vines, or climbing plants on exterior walls?
			6. Are there bushes or plants near windows that may conceal an intruder?
			7. Is there a secondary means of escape if windows are grilled above the 4th floor?
			<b>SECURITY SYSTEMS:</b>
			1. Does the dwelling have a built-in security alarm system?
			2. Does the dwelling have a built-in fire alarm system?
			3. Does the dwelling have carbon monoxide sensors?
			4. Does the dwelling have second or subsequent emergency escape points?
			5. Is there a safe-haven in case of forced entry and potential physical harm?
			<b>GARAGE:</b>
			1. Are all garage doors and windows equipped with locks?
			2. Are locks secure and in good repair?
			3. Is your POV locked and the keys removed, even when the POV is in the garage?
			4. Is the electric garage door opener secured?
			5. Are doors connecting the garage to the home secured to isolate it from the rest of the home?
			<b>OUTSIDE:</b>
			1. Is foliage trimmed or pruned near your home or pathway leading to your POV?
			2. Are all external doorways, apartment stairwells/hallways, and pathways well lit?
			3. Are motion activated lights installed on unlit exterior portions of your home?
			4. Is there a perimeter fence or barrier that deters access to the property?
			5. Are public trash dumpsters located at least 10 meters from the dwelling?
