OCONUS Family Member Screening Procedures

Call the GK Medical Clinic to make an appointment for your EFMP screening. You will need to complete the following forms **PRIOR** to your scheduled appointment at the GK clinic:

DA Form 5888, Family Member Deployment Screening Sheet (Soldier completes Part A, Sections 1-7. Personnel Service Division S1 authenticates Section 8.)

DA Form 7246, EFMP Screening Questionnaire (Soldier completes both pages of this form to provide a brief summary of Family members' medical or educational needs.)

The medical provider at GK then completes Part B of the DA 5888:

(1) If medical provider indicates on the DA 5888 that family member are not-warranted, he/she then signs the DA5888 and DA 7246.

(2) If medical provider indicates on the DA 5888 that Family member is warranted, he or she must complete an Exceptional Family Member Medical Summary (DD Form 2792, NOV 2006) to enroll, update or dis-enroll family member. The medical provider will then complete the DA 5888 and DA 7246 by signing them.

All completed forms are sent by the GK Family Member Relocation Coordinator (FMRC) to the Europe Regional Medical Command for co-signature and Army review stamp. Upon completion, the ERMC EFMP office will return the paperwork to the FMRC to give to the soldier for processing.
